4. UPDATED YEARLY TRAINING CALENDAR (YTC): Is updated and posted to <https://cacadets.org/HQ/S3/YTC> as of 27 October 2021.
5. INDIVIDUAL MAJOR AWARDS COMPETITION: Will be held 7-9 January 2022 at Camp San Luis Obispo. The registration deadline is 1 December 2021. Remember that there is no prerequisite to have participated in your Brigade IMA Competition. The Warning Order is posted to <https://cacadets.org/circulars>.
6. 10TH CORPS: Has several upcoming virtual activities planned, so be on the look for that information to be posted to the CACC website and social media in the coming weeks.
7. UPDATED C/SGT AND C/MAJ EXAM TEST AND STUDY MATERIAL: Posted to <https://cacadets.org/node/521>. Updates to the C/2LT exam test and study materials will be forthcoming soon.
8. REVISION TO CR 1-4, ADULT MEMBER PERSONNEL MANAGEMENT: Posted to <https://cacadets.org/Regulations>. This is a comprehensive revision to the October 2016 regulation. All Commandant personnel are urged to read and become familiar with the changes.
9. POSTPONEMENT OF CERT AND RECONDO TRAINING: We have had to postpone the planned CERT Training in November and the Recondo Training in December. We are tentatively rescheduling the CERT Training at CSLO to 11-13 February 2022, and we plan to offer the Recondo Training that weekend as well, in addition to another session on 14 May 2022. Be on the lookout for Warning Orders on these events.

10. SUPPLY REQUISITION FORMS AND FILLING OF SUPPLY REQUISITIONS: Have been updated and posted to <https://cacadets.org/HQ/S4/Requisitions>. An updated Form 104 (Property Book) and Form 100 (Individual Clothing Record) are published to <https://cacadets.org/node/39>. Due to complete inventory of our warehouse, supply order requisitions will not be filled until January 2021, but can still be submitted.
11. MARKSMANSHIP COMPETITION: Is scheduled for 12-13 February 2021 at Camp San Luis Obispo/ San Luis Obispo Sportsmen's Association. A Warning Order will be published in the coming weeks.

COMMANDANT TOOLS UPDATE: Promotion test results and certificates are now available on Commandant Tools, once you have logged in select the "Service Record" module then the cadet who's results/certificate you wish to view. The last promotion test(s) and results will be the last entries on the page. Not all test results from previous school years will be available.
13. ID CARDS: Adult personnel in need of an CACC ID card should email itsupport@cacadets.org.
14. CACADETS.ORG EMAIL ACCOUNT: All Commandant personnel are required to have a cacadets.org email account and actively use it to receive communication from HQCACC. All personnel should also have their email accounts synced to their smart phones to stay in communication with HQCACC.
