CALIFORNIA CADET CORPS X-TREME TEAM CHALLENGE

- 1. GENERAL: The California Cadet Corps Headquarters will hold the first annual X-treme Team Challenge (XTC) on Saturday, 29 October 2016 at the Joint Forces Training Base (JFTB) in Los Alamitos, CA. The XTC is designed to build and challenge a squad's teamwork during an applied leadership challenge. Check-in will begin at 0630 at Building 244 on 29 October 2016. The event will begin at approximately 0800 and end at approximately 1730.
- 2. PARTICIPATION: An Intent to Participate Form (Appendix A) must be submitted to SFC Dustin Dionne (dustin.dionne@cadet.org) by 30 September 2016. The intent form is also available on the Cadet Corps website at www.cadet.org/forms. Total enrollment is limited to the first 400 cadets. Each battalion may enter a team of 10 cadets (with at least three female cadets) in each of three divisions. If at least three females are not available to participate, submit roster and females will be filled with stand-by cadets. If battalions cannot fill a team with 10 cadets, their remaining positions will be filled by stand-by cadets. Battalions sending more than 10 participants per division will have their additional cadets placed on a stand-by list. The three divisions are:
 - a. Beast (grades 6-8)
 - b. Plebe (grades 9-10)
 - c. Warrior (grades 11-12)
- 3. HHC SUPPORT: Battalions are requested to bring one cadet per battalion to help facilitate the events. Supporting cadets will be eligible for the HHC ribbon and will not be charged an entrance fee.
- 4. EVENTS: There will be 10 challenges during the event; teams will participate in all 10 events and receive a cumulative score. A description of all ten events will be posted at cadet.org no later than 21 October 2016. The events are as follows:
 - a. Apocalypse Survival
 - b. Puzzle Palace
 - c. SySTEM Failure
 - d. Commo Bommo
 - e. BIVOU-Wacky
 - f. Attack the Evac
 - g. Speed Sports

- h. Balanced Approach
- i. Hollywood Cadets
- j. RECONquest
- 5. SCHEDULE FOR COMPETITION DAY: The following outline is an **approximate** itinerary for the XTC:
 - a. Check in -0630
 - b. Events begin -0800
 - c. Lunch 1145
 - d. Events continue 1230
 - e. Events end -1630
 - f. Awards presented 1700
- 6. ROSTERS: Commandants must submit accurate rosters via email (as an attachment) to SFC Dustin Dionne (dustin.dionne@cadet.org) and the 10th Corps S-1 (S1@cadet.org). Roster must include the school name, battalion number, first name, last name, rank, grade, and gender of each participant. Excel rosters must be received NLT than 7 October 2016.
 - a. Upon arrival at JFTB, team leaders are required to report to the S-1 at Building 244 to review the rosters and make adjustments as necessary.
 - b. Team leaders are also required to submit a consolidated roster of ALL CADETS AND ADULTS in attendance from their battalion to the S-1 upon check-in.
- 7. CADET SUPERVISION AND ACCOUNTABILITY: Brigade Advisors, commandant personnel, and chaperones are responsible for maintaining supervision and accountability of their cadets throughout the event (from arrival to departure) including discipline, accountability and medical services.
- 8. UNIFORMS: All participants will be in athletic gear of their choice with the following guidelines:
 - a. No Tank tops, half-shirts, exposed sports bras, tight fitting shirts, or inappropriate words, slogans, or images.
 - b. T-Shirts are appropriate and encouraged.
 - c. Shorts must be mid thigh, no bike shorts or spandex tight fitting garments are permitted.
 - d. Adult uniform is ACU or CMU.

PLEASE NOTE: If participants are dressed inappropriately, they will be asked to change or will not be allowed to participate.

9. FEES: There is an entrance fee of \$20.00 per team (\$2.00 per stand-by participant). This fee must be paid by school check, money order, or cashier's check made payable to the LEAD Foundation and will be due at the event on 28 October 2016.

- 10. TRANSPORTATION: Transportation to this event is the responsibility of the participating unit. Valid identification, vehicle registration, and current insurance are required to enter JFTB.
- 11. LODGING: Limited open-bay barracks space will be available for units that are not located in the southern California area. Units requesting barracks space must coordinate with SFC Dustin Dionne by 7 October 2016.
- 12. FOOD SERVICE: The California Cadet Corps Headquarters will provide lunch during the event; all other meals are the responsibility of the participating unit.
- 13. POINT OF CONTACT: The POC for this event is SFC Dustin Dionne.
