d. Participation Requirements: This is an open event for all Cadets invested in growing in leadership staff positions and developing themselves as leaders. We invite all cadets that have a general understanding of the California Cadets Corps Organization outlined in CR 3-22 and achieved the rank of a C/CPL or higher. Please note that C/CFCs may also apply, so long as they have experience in a brigade/battalion staff position and a basic understanding of CR 3-22. Cadets who wish to participate in this event must have a device that can connect to the internet and a working camera to allow visual accessibility during classes. There is a limit to how many cadets we are allowing to participate in this event due to the virtual environment. Thus, applications are accepted on a first-come-first-serve basis. All applications are due NLT 14 MAR 21, we will not be accepting any applications after that date. (Exceptions can be made. If you don't meet all the requirements, please still apply and we will let you know if you are accepted.)

a. Commander's Intent: No Change

b. Concept of Operations: Battle of the Shops will take place virtually via Google Classroom and Microsoft Teams. BOTS will be broken up into 3 different types of meetings: Unit, Personalized, and Event meetings. The schedule of regular Unit meetings will start on the 21st of March and end on the 14th of April. This type of meeting will be used for each group to have time with mentors. The schedule of frequent Personalized meetings will start on the 22nd of March and end on the 9th of April. These meetings will be two-hour meetings during the evening time on weekdays. The staff position you apply for will determine what day you are required to attend. Event meetings will be primarily held on Sundays and will typically last 2 hours. These meetings will consist of lessons that will benefit all cadets (e.g. classes on organizational skills, time management, communication skills, etc.). Participating cadets will only attend a total of 3 days of BOTS every week. Cadets will be asked to select the top three positions that they would like to grow in and why they would like to explore those positions in their application. Based on their three choices, each cadet will be assigned to a "mini battalion" (MBN). MBNs will consist of complete staff with a Commander, Executive Officer, Sergeant Major, and S-Shops 1-6. MBNs will be provided with basic and advanced training where they will be expected to work together and plan a mock brigade-level event. Please note that if you wish to work with a specific cadet in particular for leadership training reasons (eg. a specific

battalion's commander wishing to work with their S-1 for personalized training, you will be allowed to list that on the application and we will work to accommodate that desire.
