**1. Situation:**

- c. Start and End Times: Drill Competition team leaders check in beginning at 1800 on Friday. IMA competitors check in individually from 1800 on Friday through 1400 on Saturday. Drill Competition will conclude NLT 1700 on Saturday. IMA will conclude NLT 1200 on Sunday.

  - (3) Color Guard (Junior and Senior Division)

  - (5) Armed Platoon
  - (6) Exhibition Drill (open)
  - (7) Individual Unarmed Drill Down (Grizzly, Junior & Senior Divisions)
  - (8) Individual Armed Drill Down (open to all)
- d. Individuals compete in the following IMA Categories: No Change

- f. Each IMA competitor will have to individually complete 8 challenges as described in

CR 3-4:

- (1) Interview by an appointed board. No Change
- (2) Oral Presentation - No Change
- (3) Uniform Inspection - No Change
- (4) Written Exam - An exam covering Cadet Corps' basic knowledge and appropriate (semester-based) curriculum. The exam will consist of not less than 25 multiple choice questions. *Subject areas for each division's test are:*
  - Grizzly Division:** Drill & Ceremonies from **M3 & M7**, Uniforms from **M2**, Military Courtesy from **M8A**
  - 1st Year Cadet: M1A-C:**(Military Subjects 1 - CACC Regulations) and **M2A-C** (Military Subjects 2 - Cadet Uniform parts A-C)
  - NCO: M5B-C** (Military Subject 5 - CACC Basics part B-C) and **M8A-C** (Military Subjects 8 -Military Courtesy parts A-C)
  - Officer: C7A** (Citizenship 7A - preparing to learn), **L3C** (Leadership 3C - leadership and management), **L4B3** (Leadership 4B3 - Cadet Leadership Model), **CR 2-1** (Safety, Risk Management, & Cadet Protection).

- i. Objectives: No Change
- j. Cadet Leaders & Staff Assignments: The cadet staff and leaders for this event will be the 10th Corps Staff. HHC positions will be filled by applicants from units. Each school that is competing is requested to bring 2-5 HHC members. The minimum school grade to be HHC is 8th grade. The Headquarters and Headquarters Company ribbon will be awarded to those that participate as HHC.
- k. Application Process: Brigade Advisors must submit their intent to participate online via the links provided on the Drill Comp and IMA pages: <https://cacadets.org/Events/DrillComp> and <https://cacadets.org/Events/IMA> no later than 13 March 2020. This will include which categories the brigade will compete in for the Drill Competition (and how many teams, if the brigade-size exceeds 800), and names and category of the competitors for IMAs. Brigade Advisors may delegate registration to Commandants as long as the teams registered meet the requirement of winning at the brigade level. Commandants may register a list of individual names for IMA Competition.
- l. Cost: There will be no cost for this event.
- m. Key Suspense Dates:
  - (1) Intent Due: All brigades must submit their intent to participate by 13 March 2020 for both Drill Competition and IMA.
  - (2) Rosters Due: All brigades participating must have their Drill Team and IMA rosters submitted NLT 23 March 2020
  - (3) Contact Operations for transportation coordination: [operations@cacadets.org](mailto:operations@cacadets.org)
- n. Uniform: All participating cadets who have a CACC hydration pack should bring it. All participating cadets must be in either the full Class A or Class B uniform which complies with CR 1-8. Cadets participating in IMA Competition must bring PT Uniform. Cadets In HHC will use the Class C uniform. The preferred uniform for Commandants is ACU(OCP) or CMU. A hydration source is a part of the uniform except while competing.
- o. Awards: Awards given at these competitions will be as listed in CR 1-1, chapter 2.
- p. All drill teams must be present NLT 0700 on 18 April 2020. All IMA competitors must be present and ready to start NLT 1500 on 18 April 2020.

#### **4. Sustainment:**
