- a. Meals: Meals will be provided for this event. Because most units will not arrive by 5pm, dinner will not be provided on Friday, January 7<sup>th</sup>.   - d. Billeting: Due to Military Department policy, barracks are available only for vaccinated personnel. We will have tents available for anyone who is unvaccinated. All CACC personnel staying in barracks will be required to upload proof of vaccination (CDPH QR Code or similar) using the link provided on the [www.cacadets.org](http://www.cacadets.org) website prior to arriving at Camp San Luis Obispo. Those persons not confirmed prior arrival will be required to sleep outdoors or at an off-site hotel. Note that, should barracks become unavailable due to COVID-related circumstances, we will revert back to a virtual competition and notify the participants of this change NLT December 20<sup>th</sup>.
  - e. COVID Policies: The following policies must be enforced during IMA:
    - i. Masks must be worn inside regardless of vaccine status
    - ii. No testing required, but a cadet must have written letter from physician clearing if the cadet had COVID within the past 90 days
    - iii. All cadets will be screened for symptoms upon arrival (during in-processing) and twice daily (at morning accountability and in the evenings).
    - iv. Cadets will stay a minimum of 6-feet away from each other while inside.

## 2022 IMA Packing List

We recommend packing all items in a single duffel bag for each of transportation. You may use the single military-style duffel bags we advise for Summer Encampment, but a small duffel/suitcase is advised. Note that you will not be carrying a lot of items, so select your bag accordingly.

- (1) Complete coyote brown or white Class B uniforms, worn to event including:
  - Boots (black, CACC ISSUED) (1 pair) or dress shoes (black)
  - Trousers (black, CACC ISSUED) (1 pair)
  - Blouse (coyote brown or white, CACC ISSUED) (1 ea)
  - Belt (black, CACC ISSUED) (1 ea)
  - White T-shirt (1 ea)
- Headgear (red or black beret)
- CACC Baseball Cap (1 ea)
- Complete PT Uniform to exercise in and wear to event (1 ea)
  - Sweatshirt
  - T-shirt
  - Shorts
  - Sweats
  - Sneakers
- 1 water bottle/hydration pack
- 2 Undergarments

- 2 pairs of black boot socks or dress shoes socks
- Hygiene; please note that showers will be available for use, so pack accordingly (eg. baby wipes, toothpaste, toothbrush, lotion, washcloth, deodorant, shampoo, conditioner, body wash, towel, female hygiene products)
- Pajamas or a second set of PT gear to sleep in
- Face Masks (we will have disposable masks available, but cadets may bring their own if desired. Will need to wear a mask on the ride over per their commandant's policy.
- Hand sanitizer
- Sunscreen
- Chapstick
- Hair essentials as necessary (hair ties, bobby pins, gel, hairbrush)
- Flashlight
- Pillow
- Blanket/Padding (recommended)
- Sleeping Bag (optional – we have them to issue out if you don't have one)**

## **DO NOT BRING**

- Weapons of any kind (knives, guns, etc.)
- Drugs, alcohol, tobacco products (including e-cigarettes)
- Anything that would NOT be allowed on a school campus

These are all items we recommend you pack but this is not all you can bring. You will be **REQUIRED** to bring your uniform items (Class B and PT). **Please be mindful when packing that you are sleeping in an individual, SINGLE PERSON tent or a small barrack.**

Throughout the event, you will only be wearing Class B Uniform we provide and PT uniform to exercise in, and wear to the event.

The California Cadet Corps will be providing tents to unvaccinated cadets and we can provide sleeping bags, for uniformity reasons please do not bring your own tent.
