1. SITUATION:

- Summer Basic Commandant Training Course
- Dates: 21-28 July
- Start and End Times: 0800 hrs. 22 July/ 1200 hrs. 28 July (21 July is a Travel Day)
- Location: Camp San Luis Obispo Bldg. 1301
- Units participating: All individuals needing to obtain a Preliminary Drill Credential
- Participation Requirements: Ability to attend the entire length of the program.
- Training events planned: CSTP's, Curriculum & Planning, Basic Drill, Cadet Management, Instruction, etc. A detailed schedule of activities will be e-mailed to participants.
- Uniform is CMU or its equivalent
- **2. MISSION:** To provide the knowledge, skills, and opportunity for an individual to fulfill one of the major requirements in obtaining a TAG letter to apply for a preliminary Designated Subjects Special Subjects Basic Military Drill Credential (DSSSBMDC); which is required to be an instructor for a Cadet Corps program. The Commandant Basic Knowledge Test and all performance task evaluations will be provided (drill and ceremonies, commandant uniform wear, military courtesy, etc.).

3. EXECUTION:

- To offer a training academy to insure all commandants teaching the course are better prepared to meet the challenges of instruction, operations, and inspections in the CACC program.
- The Commandant Training Academy will focus on the criteria of operations as per Cadet
 Regulation 3-10 https://cacadets.org/sites/default/files/Regulations/CR3 10 DEC 14.pdf
- Each day will consist of approximate 8 hours of class time and 2 hours of lab/test time.
- Class Hours will be from07:30AM until 8PM
- Attendees will be given 1-hour for Lunch and dinner.
- Classes will consist of instruction, application, Drill, and group work.
- The Basic Commandant's Knowledge Test will be administered in sections during lab time.
- The hours of 6PM-8PM will be used for lab work or testing.
- Attendees not completing the entire course AND/ OR not passing the Commandant Knowledge
 Test will not be approved for The Adjutant Letter.

4. SERVICE AND SUPPORT:

- Participants will be provided contract meals at no cost to the participants beginning with the
 evening meal, from 5 pm 6:30 pm, on 21 July 2019 and ending with the morning meal on 28
 July 2019.
- Participants will be provided with open bay billets at no cost to the participants the evening of 21 July 2019 through the morning of 28 July 2019. For individuals that would like private billeting you will need to contact billeting at 805-594-6500. NOTE: Private billeting or is at the expense of the participants. See Annex 1

- HQ CACC is currently working on a billeting contract on base- If successful, participants may be reimbursed through CalAters.
- Applicants are highly encouraged to apply for the Cadet Corps prior to attending the BCTA.

- All attendees who are officially appointed members of the California Cadet Corps or members of the California National Guard or California State Military Reserve will be expected to wear the regulation ACU or OCP uniform IAW CR 1-3 and AR 670-1 or the Commandant Multipurpose Uniform (CMU) IAW Change 2 to CR 1-3 to all classes and activities during the academy.
