1. SITUATION:

- a. Name of Event/Operation: CACC Leadership Summer Encampment
- b. Dates: 16 23 June 2018
- c. Start and End Times: 0500-2200 Daily
- d. Location: Camp San Luis Obispo
- e. Units Participating: All units in the California Cadet Corps.
- f. Participation Requirements: All cadets in good standing in their respective units in the CACC with parental and commandant permission may attend.
- g. Concept of Operations: The Leadership Summer Encampment will focus on 3 training units: BST (Bear, Sword, Torch. Formerly known as Basic) Non-Commissioned Officer (NCO) Academy and Officer Candidate School (OCS). Each unit will endeavor to increase the leadership and skills at the respective levels.

2. MISSION:

a. The 10th Corps staff will conduct an annual Leadership Camp which consists of BST, NCO, and OCS to develop leaders of cadet corps and encourage cadets to take on leadership roles.

3. EXECUTION:

- a. Commander's Intent: To conduct an encampment designed to expose cadets to new experiences focused on developing leadership, skills, team building and esprit de corps. The training is designed to better cadets at different levels of their cadet career and prepare them for their next leadership role. The training will provide cadets with various opportunities to overcome a challenge, and do so with cadets from around the state. This will allow cadets to interact as a corps thus maintaining the underlying goal, which is to develop leaders of character. Training Events Planned: Basic Encampment BST, Non-Commissioned Officer Academy and Officer Candidate School
 - i. BST This unit is for cadets who are currently a Recruit, a Cadet or a Cadet First Class and are interested in obtaining the rank of C/CPL by the end of summer camp. Includes a comprehensive experience of cadet training: drill & ceremonies, bivouac, orienteering, obstacle course, LRC, Alpine Tower, marksmanship, drill competition and more.
 - ii. Non Commissioned Officer Academy This unit is for cadets who are current or aspiring NCOs. This course will focus on small unit and direct line leadership knowledge and skills. These skills are paramount for

- successful leadership at the squad leader, platoon sergeant and first sergeant positions. Includes management of formations, PT, the obstacle course, LRC, leadership training, conducting inspections, bivouac, land navigation, marksmanship and more.
- iii. Officer Candidate School This unit is for cadets who are at least a C/SSG, in grade 7-12 in the current school year and are interested in service as a cadet officer. Cadets may be commissioned to a C/2LT. Includes learning to lead large groups, teamwork, LRC, managing a staff, preparation for command, leadership skills and theories, and more.
- iv. Leadership Company, Platoon, and Battalion positions. Provides practical experience in leading a unit, building esprit de corps, and performing time management.

b. Goals

- i. Goal 1 is to create a safe, learning environment for cadets to grow as individuals and build bonds through camaraderie within both their respective units and as a corps.
- ii. Goal 2 is to develop and expand the knowledge of cadets in order to prepare them to be successful leaders at their units.

c. Objectives:

- i. 90% of cadet will pass/complete 1 of the 3 given courses..
- ii. No major injuries will occur during this event.
- iii. 100% of cadets will develop a sense of camaraderie within the California Cadet Corps.
- d. Cadet Leaders and Staff Assignments: The cadet staff and leaders for this event will be the 10th Corps Staff with selected company and platoon level leadership.
- e. Application Process: Cadets will individually submit an application starting 11 FEB 2018. The application will include the cadet's full name, rank, point of contact, medical/physical limitations, gender, and age. The application will be posted at https://cacadets.org/Events/SummerEncampment.
- f. Cost: The cost for this event is dependent on the time period of which the application is completed.
 - i. Early Bird Price: Applications completed before 15 March 2018
 - 1. \$75 for a single camp
 - 2. \$125 for both Leadership and Advanced Camp
 - ii. Regular Price: Application completed after 15 March 2018
 - 1. \$125 for a single camp
 - 2. \$200 for both Leadership and Advanced Camp
 - iii. Fees will be paid either with credit card on the Cadet Store Website (www.cadetstore.org, link available on the Summer Encampment page, or a check sent to the LEAD Foundation, PO Box 2151, Concord, CA 94521

- iv. Cadets with financial need may apply for a \$50 scholarship by emailing a request to grace.edinboro@cadet.org. Request must state the need, give parent and commandant contact information along with the cadet's rank, unit, and which programs the cadet is signing up for.
- g. Key Suspense Dates:
 - i. Application Portal Opens: 11 February 2018
 - ii. Application Portal Closes: 15 April 2018
 - 1. Any applications completed after the close date will be accepted if there are vacancies.
- h. Uniforms: Cadets are to bring their Class C and Class B uniform. Cadets are to report in Class C. Class B will be worn on graduation day.

4. SUSTAINMENT:

- a. All meals throughout the event will be provided by the CSLO Dining Facility (DFAC). DFAC able to accommodate dietary restrictions.
- b. Transportation for this event will be provided by the HQCACC. Each brigade will have a designated pick up/drop off location for their cadets. Parents are responsible for getting their cadet to and from the pick/drop off locations. Times, dates and locations to be announced.
- c. Billeting will be provided for all cadets throughout the duration of the Leadership Summer Camp.

- b. Cadet Command Sergeant Major for this event will be the 10th Corps Command Sergeant Major, C/CSM Quintero.
