- B5. Sequence the steps for adult cardiac chain of survival: Early CPR, Early defibrillation, post-cardiac arrest care, early recognition and early access to EMS, early advanced medical care
- B6. What is the best way to check to see if an adult or child is unresponsive? An infant?
- B7. Name two signs and symptoms of a heart attack.
- B8. Name a condition under which it is acceptable to stop giving CPR
