1. NEW WEBSITE: Our new California Cadet Corps website is www.cacadets.org. The old website is no longer maintained.
2. DRILL COMPETITION: The State Drill Competition results are posted at <https://cacadets.org/Events/DrillComp> and the permanent orders will be posted to <https://cacadets.org/Orders> in the coming days. If any unit did not receive their medals at the State Drill Competition please contact SSG Rogers at ryan.rogers@cadet.org.
3. STATE INDIVIDUAL MAJOR AWARDS: will be held on Saturday, 20 May 2017 at Los Alamitos Joint Forces Training Base. Refer to the circular at <https://cacadets.org/circulars>. Uniform of the day for Commandant personnel is Class B or Commandant Multipurpose Uniform (CMU).
4. JUDGES NEEDED FOR STATE INDIVIDUAL MAJOR AWARDS (IMA): Judges are needed for the State IMA Competition on Saturday, 20 May 2017 at Los Alamitos Joint Forces Training Base. If you have suitable individuals such as school/civic officials, community leaders, veteran organizations, military recruiters, or news media reporters who are interested and available to serve as judges, please send their email address to HQCACC S-5, MAJ Cook-Askins, via email at kenneth.cookaskins@cadet.org NLT 5 May 2017 so that official invitations can be sent to them.
5. 2017-2018 10th Corps Staff Selection: The 2017-2018 10th Corps Staff selection application process has been extended until **12 May 2017**. Cadets from throughout the state are encouraged to avail themselves of this opportunity to provide leadership at the statewide level. Please note that prospective 2017-2018 10th Corps staff will not attend the May drill as mentioned in the circular. The circular can be viewed at <https://cacadets.org/circulars>.
6. REQUISITIONS: Uniforms are in the process of being delivered to HQCACC from the manufactures. An email will be sent out once additional uniforms are in stock to resume filling requisitions. If you have any questions, please contact SSG Rogers at ryan.rogers@cadet.org.
7. SUMMER CAMP: The last day to sign up for Summer Camp and complete payment was 30 April 2017 for \$125.00. **Completed applications need to have fees submitted ASAP to secure their spot!** All information for Summer Camp can be found online at <https://cacadets.org/Events/SummerEncampment>. Units are filling up, so register soon to avoid having to be put on a “wait list” for the unit that you desire to attend. Summer Camp welcome letter and packing list will be published after 13 May 2017.

8. CADET STORE: The Cadet Store website is <http://www.cadetstore.org>. The website is operational for online purchasing of CACC Logo items. Adult personnel who want to have embroidered Commandant Multipurpose Uniform (CMU) shirts in time for wear at Summer Encampment, orders should be submitted NLT 12 May 2017 so that they can be ready by 20 June 2017.  9. ANNUAL PERFORMANCE LOG: Per CR 1-4, Adult annual performance logs are due to the HQCACC S-1 NLT 1 June every year. CR 1-4 states one needs a minimum of 10 hours in direct support of the CACC per school year to remain an active member of the CACC. Anyone with less than 10 hours performed for the CACC this year will be put in the inactive CACC. A second consecutive year results in discharge from the CACC. Submit you logs through your Brigade Advisor or Brigade Support Officer and they will submit your form to HQCACC S-1. Form 32, Annual Performance Log, can be viewed at in the forms section at <https://cacadets.org/node/39>.
 10. LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE: The Leadership Conference (formerly known as the Professional Development Conference) will be held 26-27 August 2017 at Camp San Luis Obispo. Please ensure you start submitting required off campus activity paperwork to your school district now, since this will be an overnight activity. The Leadership Conference circular is posted at <https://cacadets.org/circulars>.
 11. 2017-2018 HQCACC YTC: Has been published and can be viewed at <https://cacadets.org/node/227>. Please ensure you place these dates on your calendar.
 12. BCTA/ACTA/CLS: Circulars for Basic Commandant Training Academy (BCTA), Advanced Commandant Training Academy (ACTA), and Commander Leadership School (CLS) are posted to <https://cacadets.org/circulars>. Reminder that BCTA and ACTA are needed if you desire to be promoted. BCTA is also needed if you desire to obtain the Designated Subjects Specials Subjects Basic Military Drill Credential. Commandant Leadership School (CLS) is a new course (CACC Version of OCS) designed for those enlisted Commandant personnel interested in gaining the knowledge and skills necessary to commission as a CACC Officer. Refer to CR 1-4 to review the requirements for Commandant promotions.
 13. HIGH SCHOOL SENIOR DATA COLLECTION: HQCACC has developed a method to collect data on what our Cadets do after graduating from the CACC (college, trade school, military, service academy, workforce, etc.). NLT 26 May 2017 Commandants are to complete the online
